Stelmach House Restoration Project

During the Ukrainian Day Festival on August 10, 2014 at the Ukrainian Cultural Heritage Village, a sod turning ceremony took place on the future site of the Stelmach Homestead House. Throughout last year and into the summer of 2014, restoration had begun with the most essential tasks undertaken for the house to weather the long winter. New roof shingles were installed, decaying log beams were replaced, and additional structural reinforcement was put in place prior to the final move. On October 3, 2014 the former home of Mr. Ed Stelmach's grandparents was moved from the top of the hill at the Ukrainian Village, to the permanent site and foundation, located close to highway 16 at the Village site. UCC-APC continues to raise funds to complete this special project, and was

CFEP grant from the Alberta Culture in support of this project, presented by MLA Jacquie Fenske. The goal for completion and opening of this new building at the UCHV is for the 125th anniversary of Ukrainian Settlement in Canada, 2016-17, and donations can be directed specifically to this project.

Hetman Banquet Gala

This year's Hetman Gala and UCC APC 40th Anniversary Celebration was held at St. John's Cultural Centre in Edmonton on October 18, 2014. Prior to the dinner, the Alberta Council for the Ukrainian Arts sponsored an art show featuring Alberta Ukrainian artists Valeriy Semenko, Larysa Eliuk-Matchak, Iryna Karpenko and Char Vanderhorst. Semen Kostyuk provided a musical interlude on his bayan (accordian) inspiring spontaneous singing among guests and participants. The evening proceeded with MC- Volodymyr Boychuk welcoming guests. Olesia Luciw-Andryjowycz, President, gave opening remarks, followed by the awards and dinner. The Volya Dance Ensemble and Axios Choir provided entertainment for the evening, honouring the recipients of the Hetman Awards. As part of the 40th Anniversary celebrations, Daria Luciw and Olesia Luciw-Andryjowycz gave a presentation reflecting on the important benchmarks for the Alberta Ukrainian Community over the last 40 years.



MEDICAL PROJECT IN UKRAINE

In May 2014 the Canada Ukraine Foundation (CUF) signed an agreement with Caritas Ukraine, located in Lviv, to provide medical assistance to some of the Maidan victims. Caritas has hired three people to work on this project. The database of injured from Maidan was analyzed to select 30 most needed persons and members of their families to receive medical, psychological, social and legal aid.

As of December 1, 2014 the majority of the group have completed medical and psychological rehabilitation

programs as per individualized care plans. Six heavily wounded Maidan victims will continue rehabilitation until the end of January. In November 2014 CUF and Caritas Ukraine also started a project aimed at psychological rehabilitation of 200 ATO soldiers and members of their families. The results will be reported in March 2015. On November 7, 2014 another CUF mission arrived in Kyiv Ukraine and performed 50 reconstructive surgeries on wounded soldiers. Nurses from Alberta, Nadia Warchola and Elizabeth Procinski took part in this mission.

Art for Aid - November 29, 2014

On November 29, 2014 the Ukrainian Community gathered at St. Joseph's High School rotunda in support of "Art for Aid". Over 20 artists donated their works in support of humanitarian aid for Ukraine. The afternoon began with our MC's, Olha Hyzha and Taras Bukovskyy welcoming all to this event. Soloist Anna Chudak from St. Paul opened the day with our national anthems, O Canada and the Ukrainian Anthem "Shche Ne Vmerla Ukrainy". This was followed by a series of performances by Viter Choir, Acolada, Julian Eveneshen, Johnathan Hlus, My Ukrainian Dance Academy, Ruta, Nikolai Shapka, Tanya Strilets, Lesia Hyzha, and Mikylie Shapka.

The proceeds from the sale of all artwork has gone directly to purchase warm clothing for

the volunteer soldiers in Ukraine. Over \$8,000.00 was raised at this event. To date over 600 kg of boots, jackets, socks, underclothing, balaklavas, and gloves have been sent to Ukraine through Orbit Ukrainian Store at no cost, where it has been distributed to the frontlines.
